

Representative Project:

Town of Lochbuie, CO Land Development Code

Plan Tools, LLC worked in association with MDBR and Matrix Design Group to update and consolidate the Town of Lochbuie's land use regulations into a unified development code.

Key enhancements include:

- Using tables to consolidate text, e.g., creating a single chart to provide a central reference point for the Town's multiple development review procedures.
- Including graphics to illustrate sign types, architectural detail, vison clearance, and definitions for frontage, lots, yards and setbacks.
- Updating the Town's sign regulations to be compliant with the content-neutral requirements of the Reed v. Town of Gilbert case.
- Adding flood damage prevention regulations to be compliant with the requirements of the Colorado Water Conservation Board.
- Updating the Town's oil and gas regulations to be consistent with current case law and the requirements of the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission.
- Creating checklists to detail submittal requirements for each type of land use application.

The Lochbuie Land Development Code was unanimously adopted in October 2017.
